Jobs in this sector include plumbers, electricians, builders, bricklayers, tilers, scaffolders, carpenters, refrigeration mechanics, carpet layers, mechanics, glaziers, landscapers, labourers, painters, plasterers, roofers, steelworkers and stonemasons.
